**Sub: Amendment of merit point calculation & Repeal of the provision of deduction of merit points in UG (1<sup>st</sup> Semester) Admission in UG Colleges under CBCS for the Academic Session 2022-2023.**

Respected Sir/Madam,

As directed by the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, University of Gour Banga, Malda and in partial amendment of earlier Notice Ref. No.: 341/UGB/DR-2021, Dated: 22.07.2021, this is for information of all concerned that for the purpose of Admission to the UG Courses in the General Degree Colleges, affiliated under the University of Gour Banga, in the Academic Session 2022-2023 the Selection Criteria and the Merit Point Calculation and will be amended as follows:

**1. Amendment of merit point calculation:**

(i) a) for Honours/Core Courses:  $(S+T)/4$ .

[Where S = Subject marks (opted for Honours/Core Course) and T = Marks obtained in English + best marks of two other subjects (excluding EVS and the subject opted for Honours/Core Course)].

b) In case, any candidate opts for an Honours/Core Course beyond his/her subject combination [except linguistic subjects at H.S. (10+2) level], the merit point will be calculated as:  $T_1/4$ .

[Where  $T_1$  = Marks obtained in English + best marks of three other subjects (excluding EVS and English)].

(ii) For General/Program Course the merit point calculation formula will be the same as i) b) above.

**2. Repeal of the provision of deduction of merit points:**

With effect from the Academic Session 2022-2023, the provision of deduction of the merit points (5% or 10%) of the candidates applying for admission but have passed in previous years (ref. clause no. 7 of the admission notification No. 341/UGB/DR-2021 Dated: 22.07.2021 of the University of Gour Banga) will be repealed.

As directed by the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, University of Gour Banga, Malda and in pursuance to the Notification vide No. 706-Edn(CS)/10M095/14 dated 13<sup>th</sup> July, 2021 issued by the Deputy Secretary, Dept. of Higher Education, Govt. of West Bengal and on the basis of the Resolution of the Meeting with the Principals/Teachers in Charge/Officers in Charge of all the affiliated Colleges under University of Gour Banga, Malda, held on 20.07.2021, this is to notify all concerned that the Online UG Admission Process for the Academic Session 2021-2022 shall be processed in line with the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS).

In this connection, all General Degree Colleges affiliated to the University of Gour Banga, Malda are requested to maintain the guideline of the above mentioned Notification of the Dept. of Higher Education, Govt. of West Bengal, as hereunder for the **Online Admission Procedure** at UG Level for various courses of studies in different Colleges under UGB in the 1<sup>st</sup> Semester for Academic Session 2021-2022. The tentative schedule is as follows:

4.	Publication of Merit Lists in UG Courses by	<b>31.08.2021</b>
5.	Completion of Admission at the UG Courses by	<b>30.09.2021</b>
6.	Start of 1 <sup>st</sup> Semester of UG Courses on	<b>01.10.2021</b>

The following steps are also resolved regarding the UG Online Admission Process for the Academic Session 2021-2022:

1. The detail schedule of 'On Line Registration' for the Academic Session 2021-2022 shall be intimated later on by the University authority.
2. Eligibility Criteria of admission for the Academic Session 2021-2022 for various UG courses of studies will be at par with the norms followed in Academic Session 2020-2021.
3. Subject to the eligibility criteria, the merit lists for the General Courses will be prepared on the basis of Grand Total of best five subjects.

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4. Candidates qualifying in (10+2) Exam. with English as a Subject of the West Bengal State Council for Vocational Education & Training shall have to comply with Sl. No.: 6 and are eligible to get admission to B.A. and B.Com. General Course only.
5. Student passing out only from the State Level and National Level Boards in regular mode will be allowed to take admission in Honours/General Course.
6. The selection criteria and merit will be prepared as per the provisions of the University. The Merit Point Calculation will be done as follows:
  - (a) Subject to the eligibility criteria, the merit lists for the Honours Courses will be prepared as:  
**Subject (opted for Honours) + Grand Total**

  - (b) In case any candidate opts for an Honours beyond his subject combination (Except linguistic subjects) at H.S. (10+2) Level, the merit lists for the Honours Courses will be prepared as:  
**0 (Zero) + Grand Total**

7. 5% and 10% merit point will be deducted from total merit points credited to the students who have passed 12<sup>th</sup> Standard in 2020 and 2019 respectively.
8. The Registration Fee will remain unchanged for the session 2021 – 2022. The University Sports Fee of Rs.10 (Rupees Ten) per student has been waived for the session 2021 – 2022, considering the nCOVID-19 situation.
9. In case of doubts / confusions in preparing the Merit Lists or in any other respect whatsoever, clarification may be obtained from the University.
10. All are hereby requested to maintain compulsorily their existing intake capacity as approved by the University.
11. All are also requested to adhere to the COVID-19 norms/protocol, issued by the Government from time to time.
