Note:

1. 2. All the students admitted in session 2023-2024 but did not appear in the examination will have to pursue their studies as per the modified curriculum (i.e., the curriculum followed by the students, admitted in the session 2024-2025).
3. The students who did not qualify UG Semester I Examinations 2023 (as per NEP-2020) (i.e., with Result Status 'SF' **Semester Failed**) may pursue their studies in the new curriculum i.e., the curriculum followed by the students, admitted in the session 2024-2025.
